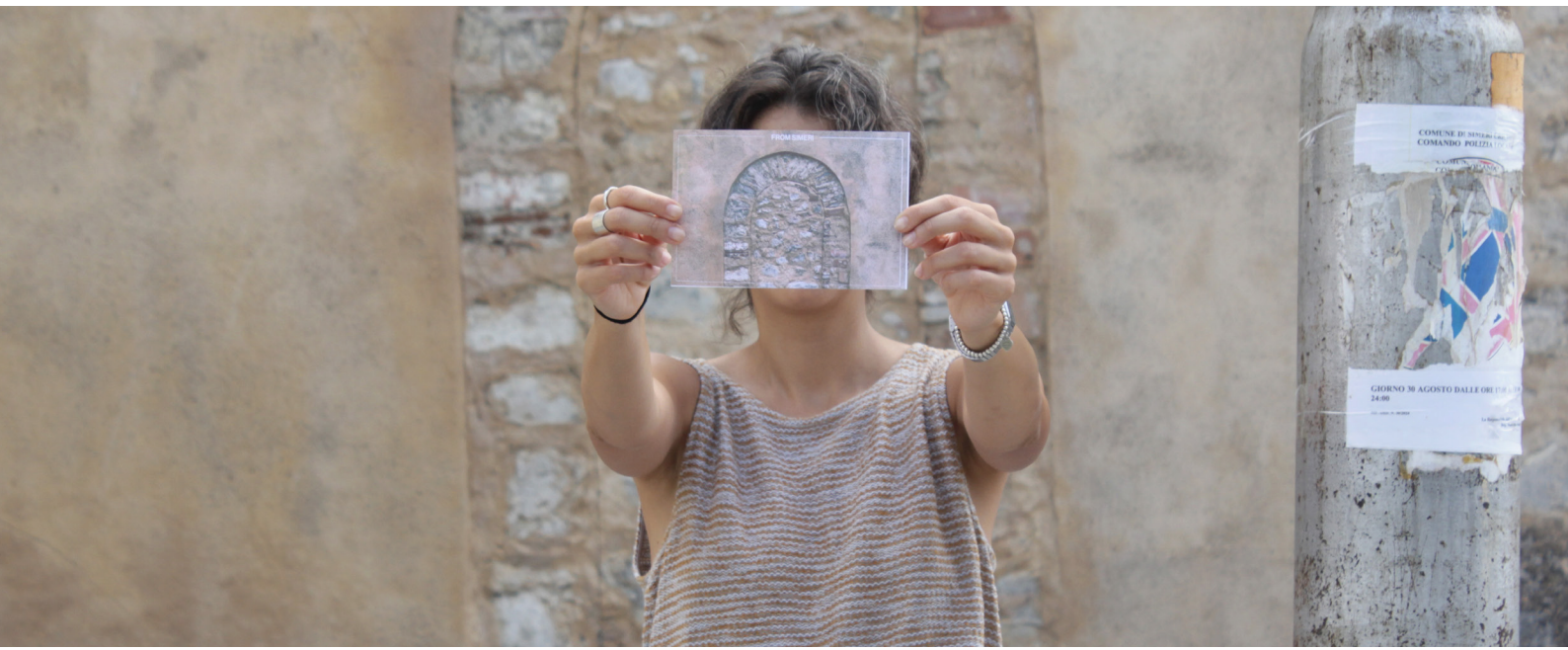
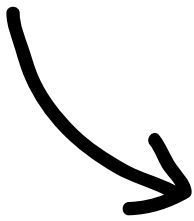


Erasmus+ internship opportunity in southern Italy: Join our collective Simeri Laboratorio Urbano.
