

Dear students,

this semester you are going to start the Master Programme Spatial Planning at the Technical University of Dortmund.

The binding registration for the seminars will take place from the 22th of March until the 24th of March 2023 and will be held online via „LimeSurvey“. Every student will receive an Email in advance, containing the Web-Link // Please check www.raumplanung.tu-dortmund.de for the correct link to participate in the registration.

We summarized some important details regarding the process of the procedure as well as helpful instructions that should guide you through.

Step 1



Please note that you can only insert numbers for current semester and no. of seminars (e.g. 2, not two). The no. of semesters only refers to the **Master Programme**, so if you just started you have to insert 1 for 1st semester.

During the Master Programme you have to do 4 seminars in module 3 and 1 seminar in module 1



*** if you are starting the programme in this semester, you have to choose the study structure of 2020**

The indication of the **specialisation** is just a selection criterion to help registering you for a seminar in the indicated field. You are not choosing a specialisation for the whole Master Programme.

Step 2

*** you can choose 3 seminars per course**

Example for choosing seminars in module 3:

Course 1

- 1st priority: desired seminar
- 2nd priority: alternative 1.1
- 3rd priority: alternative 1.2

Course 2

- 1st priority: desired seminar II
- 2nd priority: alternative 2.1
- 3rd priority: alternative 2.2

Course 3

- 1st priority: desired seminar III
- 2nd priority: alternative 3.1
- 3rd priority: alternative 3.2

Course 4

- 1st priority: desired seminar IV
- 2nd priority: alternative 4.1
- 3rd priority: alternative 4.2

>> Please be aware that we cannot consider time overlaps when assigning the seminars. <<

We recommend not to do all necessary seminars in one semester!

Example 1

1st semester

- 1 graded seminar module 3
- 1 ungraded seminar module 3
- + project or urban design

2nd semester

- 1 grade seminar module 3
- 1 ungraded seminar module 3
- graded seminar module 1
- master thesis

Example 2

1st semester

- 2 graded seminars module 3
- + project or urban design

2nd semester

- 2 ungraded seminars module 3
- graded seminar module 1
- master thesis
