What funding opportunities or scholarships are available?	<ul> <li>There are no funding opportunities or scholarships at the Ardhi University.</li> </ul>
How much is the tuition fee?	<ul> <li>There is no tuition fee for exchange students from TU Dortmund University.</li> </ul>
Are there any other academic expenses? If yes, how much?	Other expenses can be found at <u>www.aru.ac.tz</u>
Can you provide a website or file with the student hostels/accommodations for the exchange students?	<ul> <li>There are limited accommodation facilities on campus that can accommodate the increasing student demand, including exchange students. The available rooms have the basics, like a bed, a wardrobe, a ceiling fan, a chair, and a table. The bathroom and toilet are shared. The monthly rental fee is TZZS 360,000. There are, however, accommodation facilities outside the campus, some of which are within walking distance and have rental fees ranging from USD 250 to 500. Upon request from the respective students, the Department can assist exchange students in obtaining such accommodation from outside the University.</li> </ul>
How is the process to apply for the student hostel?	<ul> <li>Upon receiving the application or a letter from the host university, the coordinator applies for the students</li> </ul>
How much is the monthly rent (approx.)?	<ul> <li>Approx. 150 Euros per semester in the University dormitories</li> <li>USD 200 to 250 in the private fully furnished apartments</li> </ul>
Are there other platforms through which students can find flats or shared flats?	They can find private apartments outside the university. (personal arrangements)
